Founded in 1894, and coeducational since 1968, Pomfret School is an independent college preparatory boarding and day school for 350 students in grades 9 through 12 and postgraduates. Set on a beautiful 500-acre campus in northeastern Connecticut and brought to life by an exceptional faculty, Pomfret offers students a rich and rewarding educational experience.

With an outstanding reputation in the independent school world, Pomfret is known for its stable leadership, competitive admissions, challenging academic program, accomplished athletic teams, and vibrant arts program. In particular, the academic experience at Pomfret is rigorous (offering 37 Advanced Placement and Honors courses) yet supportive. Class sizes are small – averaging 12 students – and the student:faculty ratio is 6:1. Highly accomplished faculty serve as teachers, coaches and advisors and most live on campus. Attention to each student's individual progress is a priority for Pomfret faculty. Pomfret's students hail from 14 countries and 25 states. Approximately 75% are boarding students and 13% are students of color. The community is warm and inviting and embodies school pride and spirit.

Financially, the school has a balanced budget of \$15.5 million and a \$36.5 million endowment. The annual giving program seeks to raise \$1,825,000 in 2009-2010. The *Priorities for Pomfret* Capital Campaign, which was completed in 2007, raised over \$48 million. With a committed faculty, selective admissions, supportive parent body, loyal alumni and visionary Board of Trustees, Pomfret is well positioned for continued success.
